My name is James Grandberry
I am currently incarcerated at the
Brown County Jail. March 6th 2025,
You wrote a article publishing a picture
of the the motion I filed with the Brown
County Court requesting that my case be
dismissed. The reason was the court loses
jurisdiction once they violate a persons
rights which the court did when they failed
to appoint me an attorney and also afford
me the opportunity within the 10 day period
set by the Wisconsin Supreme Court. Yes,
the county is a Crisis State with the public
defenders office not being able to appoint
attorneys fast enough to satisfy incarcerated
individuals needs. But the courts do have
the option to appoint private attorneys so that
us accused individuals have our rights to be
proven innocent upheld. To this day I have been
held at the Brown County Jail without a
attorney which has now pushed it to over a
year my rights have been in violation. The court
can not hide behind the excuse of a budget
shortfall to hold individuals unjustly. The Nhia
Lee case that was cited in the motion that

You published spelled out that the courts must not hide behind the public defender shortage to hold accused individuals for extreme amounts of time to protect the County the cost of appointing someone to represent them. I would ask that you please publish this letter so that the public knows the details of what injustices are being displayed by the Brown County Court System. We have the right for our voices to be heard.
